Victim Survivor Referral Pathway

A victim survivor discloses family violence to a non-specialist service. If the victim survivor is in immediate danger, Police are notified. Otherwise, service refers to local Family Violence Service or Safe Steps for a referral to a refuge.



Services use the Family Violence Information Sharing Scheme and MARAM to assess and manage risk.




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Police attend family violence incident and make formal referral (L17) to **Family Violence Service.**

Family Violence Services can help adult and child victim survivors of family violence. Some Family Violence Services can also help people who use family violence to take responsibility and change their behaviour.





A victim survivor attends Court to apply for a Family Violence Intervention Order or a Variation.

A victim survivor can contact Family Violence Service and self-refer.
